SSSVV is a practical framework to empower teachers with Content, Training and Teaching aids.

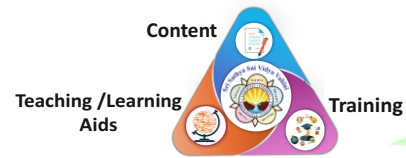
**Harnesses Technology**

The SSSVV project is a global collaboration between educators, trainers and technologists, inspired by Bhagawan Baba's call to Love All and Serve All.

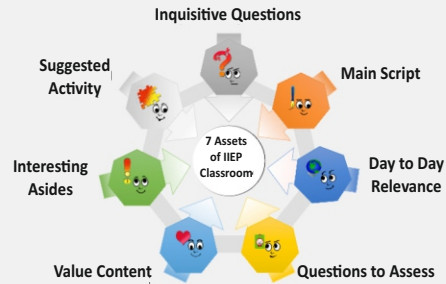
**Inclusive Outlook**

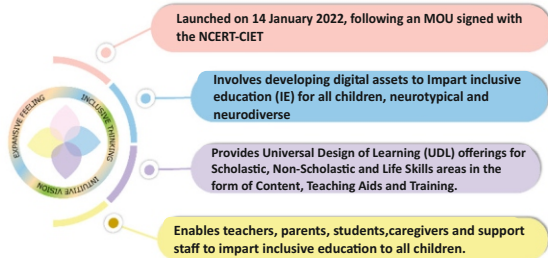


## Classroom content

Creating Lifelong Learners

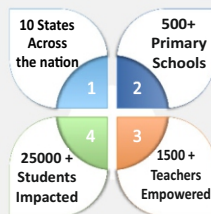
Sopaan which means a ladder- is a bilingual, foundational learning program that aims to help children blossom into lifelong learners
